IATF and ISO Certificates

As a result of the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic, Champlain Cable is following the guidance of the IATF- the International Automotive Task Force. In accordance with the IATF Global Waivers and Measures in Response to the Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) all certificates were extended by 6 months from original date of expiration. Certificates of validity can be verified [HERE](#). This applies to Champlain Cable's IATF 16949:2016 certificate that originally had expired on December 23, 2020 and this has now been extended through June 24, 2021. We currently have a remote audit scheduled for February 2021 in order to retain our certificate and fully anticipate remaining compliant with all relevant requirements.

The committee that developed the ISO certifications originally built in a period of 6 months that allows for retaining a certificate during which recertification can take place. This is being utilized by both our Colchester, Vermont (ISO 14001 and ISO 9001) and El Paso, Texas (ISO 9001) facilities. All certifications will be maintained in accordance with the requirements for certification. At the point that a new certificate is issued for any facility, our website will be updated. For customers with portal information, new certificates will be uploaded to their portals.
