The quality technician will utilize specialized test equipment including but not limited to microscopes, Kocour testing with chemicals, testing of tooling, dies, and emulsions. This role will help with both product and process quality to ensure we are able to produce consistent product quality. Calibration of equipment will be conducted by this role. Utilization of a computer will be vital throughout the role.

This position will serve as an auditor of production process to assist and improve processes. Job requires bending and pushing with weight limits ranging from 20 to 60 lbs.

This position will also assist in the maintenance and upkeep of production tooling in a detailed manner.
